INSTRUCTIONS FOR CONDUCT OF MGM MAT: ENTRANCE TEST FOR ADMISSION TO MBA POSTGRADUATE PROGRAMME OFFERED BY MGM INSTITUTE OF MANAGEMENT AND RESEARCH FOR THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2020 – 2021.

INTRODUCTION:

As a constituent institute of MGM University, Aurangabad, MGM Institute of Management and Research invites application to its 4 Semester MBA (Fulltime) and 6 Semester MBA (Part-time) program for the year 2020-2021. The admission is through an entrance test. MGM University accepts scores of MH CET, CAT, MAT, CMAT, XMAT and ATMA. Scores of 2018, 2019 and 2020 are acceptable.

MGM University will conduct its own entrance exam also for its MBA program which will be named as MGM MAT II. The score of MGM MAT II will be accepted by the University for Admission to its MBA program. These instructions are applicable to the conduct of MGM MAT.

1. DEFINITIONS

- (a) “Act” means the Maharashtra Unaided Private Professional Educational Institutions (Regulation of Admissions and Fees) Act, 2015 (Mah. Act XXVIII of 2015).
- (b) “All India Seats” means seats available to an eligible Indian National Candidate.
- (c) “Application Form” means prescribed form filled up online by the candidate for admission.
- (d) “Competent Authority” means the Registrar, MGM University Aurangabad.
- (e) “Program” means the postgraduate management courses MBA Full Time and MBA Part Time.
- (f) “Eligible Candidates” means the candidates who are eligible for different professional courses as notified by the MGMU, Aurangabad.
- (g) “Inter-Se-Merit” means the order of merit in respect of various classes/ category of the candidates.
- (h) “CMAT” means the Common Management Aptitude Test which is conducted by the AICTE.
- (i) “Qualifying Examination” means examinations on the basis of which a candidate becomes eligible for admission or its equivalent examination;
- (j) “NRI” means Non-Resident Indian;

2. SCHEME OF EXAMINATION

2.1 MGMMAT II

- (a) **Date of Examination:** The examination will be conducted by Online mode (Computer Based Test) on 29th August 2020.
- (b) **Syllabus, Weightage and Pattern of Examination:** Test can be taken by the students who want to become eligible for admission to MBA programs at MGM University and do not have any other score acceptable to the university. The test will consist of the following sections:

Sections	Weightage
Mathematics	25%
English	25%
Logical Reasoning (Verbal and Nonverbal)	25%
Data Interpretation	25%

- (c) If a candidate has an objection against any question in the question paper of this examination, the same may be submitted through candidate login. Representation received by any other means shall not be considered.
- (d) **Language of Question Paper:** The medium of examination shall be English.
- (e) **Examination Centre:** The MGMMAT 2020 will be conducted by online mode (CBT-Computer Based Test).

3. Syllabus:

3.1 Mathematics:

This section of MGMMAT will contain 25 questions carrying one mark each. Following are the topics from which questions will be asked in this section.

1. Numerical Calculations – Number, Percentages etc.
2. Arithmetic problems involving ratio and proportions, partnership, work and wages, partnership etc.
3. Questions on quantitative reasoning – Problems of speed and time.
4. Data sufficiency

3.2 English:

This section of MGM MAT will consist of 25 questions carrying one mark each. This section tests language ability of the student. Following are the topics on which the questions will be asked in this section.

1. Reading comprehension
2. English Grammar
3. Sentence completion.
4. Vocabulary
5. Synonyms
6. Antonyms
7. Choice of appropriate phrase, word and expression.

8. Jumbled Paragraph

3.3 Logical Reasoning:

This shall include the questions to measure how quickly and logically you can think. This section will cover logical situations and questions based on the facts given in the passage. This test shall check the problem-solving capability of the candidate. This section also covers 25 questions carrying one mark each. It includes the following topics.

1. Series
2. Ranks
3. Directions
4. Coding and decoding
5. Analogy and classification
6. Syllogism
7. Statement and conclusion

3.4 Data Interpretation:

This section of MGMMAT will test the students' speed, decision-making capability and analysis of data skills. This section will also cover 25 questions carrying one mark each. It covers the following topics:

1. Tables
2. Bar Graphs
3. Pie Charts
4. Line Charts
5. Venn Diagram
6. Column Graphs

6. Important Instructions to the MGMMAT II candidates.

- a) The Online Question Paper will contain Multiple Choice Questions (MCQs) with Four options (answers) for each question.
- b) Each question will have Four alternatives (answers) out of which only one alternative/answer will be the correct.
- c) There is no Negative Marking.
- d) Questions will be available in English language only.

7. Online Application Form

Application Form for MGMMAT II will be filled through Online Mode (CBT-Computer Based Test) only. The information brochure for MGMMAT II and the user manual for filling up the online application form is available on web site "www.mgmio.org". Candidates may download and print the user manual for filling up the online application form.

For submission of online application form the candidates should login at www.mgmio.org website. The detailed procedure for online submission of application form is given in the user manual. Please quote your Application no. in all future correspondence with In-charge CET Cell Office.

- a) The Online Application Submission is four step process:
 - Registration – Creation of Username and Password
 - My Application – Filling up Application Form
 - Upload of Photograph and Signature – Candidate must upload their recent Photograph and Signature in Online system.
 - Payment of Fees – Candidate can make payment of Fee using Online Payment mode only.

8. MGMMAT II Application Fee Payment:

8.1 Application form processing fees as stated below is to be paid through online mode for which the service charges as per rules shall be applicable in addition to the application form processing fees. This fee is non-refundable and non-transferable under any circumstances.

8.2 Fee. For all Category Candidates from Maharashtra State, Outside Maharashtra State(OMS), J & K Migrant candidates the application fees for MGMMAT is Rs. 1000/-.

9. Registration Process Completion:

On successful payment of the application fee, a confirmation of the same will be displayed online. Candidates shall print the receipt for future references. After successful payment, the Candidate shall take the print out of its online application form. Keep a copy of MGMMAT II Application No., Log-In ID & Password.

10. Declaration of Result

- a) The Competent Authority will conduct the examination, evaluate the answer sheets and declare the result. The result will be declared on websites www.mgmim.org as per the schedule.
- b) The Competent Authority shall invite application for admission and after verification of documents and eligibility, publish the Merit Lists as per the Rules.

11. Conduct and Discipline

- Failure of the candidate in entering full and correct information in the online application form and/or suppression of any information would lead to disqualification of the candidate for MGM MAT II or even at a later date. Such a candidate will be debarred from the examination / entire selection process.
- If any person(s) or officer(s) dealing with the conduct of the MG MU CET II are found engaged in act(s) that would result in the leakage of question paper or attempt to use or help in the use of unfair means in this examination, he/she shall be liable to prosecution under Indian Penal Code.
- Any issue not dealt here-in above will be dealt with, when arising, fully and finally by the competent authority. Any amendments made by Registrar, MGM University Aurangabad from time to time will be implemented.
